

NAME

puts, fputs — put a string on a stream

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <stdio.h>
```

```
int puts (s)
```

```
char *s;
```

```
int fputs (s, stream)
```

```
char *s;
```

```
FILE *stream;
```

DESCRIPTION

Puts copies the null-terminated string *s* to the standard output stream *stdout* and appends a new-line character.

Fputs copies the null-terminated string *s* to the named output *stream*.

Neither routine copies the terminal null character.

DIAGNOSTICS

Both routines return EOF on error.

NOTES

Puts appends a new-line, *fputs* does not.
